NOTE: Departments and courses exempt from these time blocks are: (1) off-campus courses, (2) self-contained programs (AUTO, Athletics and Cosmetology), (3) ENG 100 and English Skills classes that fit into their priority classrooms (the classes that do not fit in their priority classrooms must conform to this template), (4) studio classes (e.g. studio art, music, theater and film production) that are scheduled in their specialized facilities, (5) classes that meet four or more hours one day a week, as long as the morning session ends in time for students to enroll in an afternoon class (12:45 p.m. or 2:20 p.m.) and (6) short courses that meet only on Friday. Hybrid class should not block a regularly scheduled classroom for occasionally meeting classes. Hybrid class meetings (combination of online and on-campus) should be scheduled on a Friday, Saturday or in combination with other hybrid classes.
